

Goodbye Troubles, Hello Bubbles Scramble

Mary called the general meeting to order and introduced Chris Bensel, our CCC golf pro.

Sandy McCallister reminded Niners to register for the Championship Tournament. The registration book is in the golf club lounge. Registration closes on August 10. She reminded everyone to be familiar with the following rules:

1. Be ready to tee off on time.
2. Have two golf balls marked with your ID.
3. Exchange scorecards with another player in your foursome at the first hole. Keep your own score at the top of the card.
4. No gimmies on putts. Record putts on the scorecard.
5. As you finish each hole, verify your score.
6. There is a limit of three minutes to search for a lost ball.
7. Hitting the wrong ball is a two-stroke penalty. Both balls must be replaced and hit again.
8. Whiffs count as a stroke.
9. Mark your ball on the green. Hitting an opponent's ball is a two-stroke penalty on the golfer whose ball was hit.
10. Loose impediments may be removed from penalty areas or bunkers.
11. A hazard drop zone may only be used if the ball is in the hazard with a one-stroke penalty.
12. Carol Zinsli reminded golfers that if you lift the ball from the putting green, the person lifting the ball must replace the ball; otherwise, there's a 2-stroke penalty.

Pink Ball – Mary Fieweger said that registration is filling up quickly for the Pink Ball Tournament. We can accommodate 180 golfers. The committee is still accepting gift baskets and other auction items including bottles of wine with a value of \$30 or more. There will be a paddle raise. An OHSU representative from the Knight Cancer Institute will attend. A current patient at the Institute will speak at the lunch.

Mary F. reminded everyone that the end of the year Niners' show is September 28 at 4 p.m. They will perform for the Niners' before the general public. Most of the general public tickets have already been sold.
