Spotlight on ladies Niners rules — Bonnie Bohm, rules chairperson

Pick-up: The Niners Rules is par plus five. For a par 3, once you have reached eight strokes you should pick up your ball and continue play on the next hole. On a Par 4 once you have reached 9 strokes, do the same. Once you record a pick up, you are not able to record your putts for the day's play. This enables us to keep pace of play, which is to be two hours or less.

Water hazard — In the water? You have the option to use the Niners drop zone and/or hit another drive from the tee. Both have a one-stroke penalty. Don't see the drop zone (white circle)? Chris Bensel said it is supposed to be there every Tuesday for us! If not, he feels we know where the circle should be and drop your ball in the vicinity, of course no closer to the hole.
